**Temporary Restraining Order, Including a Temporary Injunction, A
Temporary Asset Restraint, Expedited Discovery, and Order to Show Cause**

THIS CAUSE being before the Court on Plaintiff *Ex Parte* Motions for Entry of a Temporary Restraining Order, Including a Temporary Injunction, a Temporary Asset Restraint, and Expedited Discovery (the “Motion”) against the defendants identified in the Complaint (the “Defendants”) and using at least the online marketplace accounts identified in **Exhibit A** hereto (the “Defendant Online Stores”), and this Court having heard the evidence before it hereby GRANTS Plaintiff’s Motion in its entirety.

This Court further finds that it has personal jurisdiction over the Defendants since the Defendants directly target their business activities toward consumers in the United States. Specifically, Defendants are reaching out to do business with United States residents by operating one or more commercial, interactive

Defendant Online Stores through which United States residents can purchase products using counterfeit versions of the Plaintiff Works.

This Court also finds that issuing this Order without notice pursuant to Rule 65(b)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure is appropriate because Plaintiff has presented specific facts in the Declaration of Wumei Lin, and accompanying evidence clearly showing that immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage will result to the movant before the adverse party can be heard in opposition.

Specifically, in the absence of an *ex parte* Order, Defendants could and likely would modify registration data and content and move any assets from accounts in U.S.-based financial institutions, including Amazon Pay accounts, to offshore accounts. *Id.* Proceedings against those who deliberately traffic in counterfeit merchandise are often useless if notice is given to the adverse party.

Accordingly, this Court orders that:

1. Defendants, their affiliates, officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, confederates, and all persons acting for, with, by, through, under, or in active concert with them be temporarily enjoined and restrained from:
 - a. using the Plaintiff Works or any reproductions, counterfeit copies or colorable imitations thereof in any manner in connection with the distribution, marketing, advertising, offering for sale, or sale of any

- product that is not a genuine Plaintiff product or not authorized by Plaintiff to be sold in connection with the Plaintiff Works;
- b.** passing off, inducing, or enabling others to sell or pass off any product as a genuine Plaintiff product or any other product produced by Plaintiff, that is not Plaintiff's or not produced under the authorization, control or supervision of Plaintiff and approved by Plaintiff for sale under the Plaintiff Works;
 - c.** committing any acts calculated to cause consumers to believe that Defendants' products are those sold under the authorization, control, or supervision of Plaintiff, or are sponsored by, approved by, or otherwise connected with Plaintiff;
 - d.** further infringing the Plaintiff Works and damaging Plaintiff's commercial goodwill;
 - e.** otherwise competing unfairly with Plaintiff in any manner;
 - f.** manufacturing, shipping, delivering, holding for sale, transferring or otherwise moving, storing, distributing, returning, or otherwise disposing of, in any manner, products or inventory not manufactured by or for Plaintiff, nor authorized by Plaintiff to be sold or offered for sale, and which bear any of Plaintiff's Works, or any reproductions, counterfeit copies, or colorable imitations thereof; and

g. using, linking to, transferring, selling, exercising control over, or otherwise owning or operating the infringing webstores, websites, or any other domain name that is being used to sell or is the means by which Defendants could continue to sell Counterfeit Products.

2. Defendants and any third party with actual notice of this Order who is providing services for any of the Defendants, or in connection with any of the Defendant Online Stores or other online marketplace accounts operated by Defendants, including, without limitation, any online marketplace platforms such as Amazon, eBay, web hosts, sponsored search engine or ad-word providers, credit cards, banks, merchant account providers, third party processors and other payment processing service providers such as PayPal and Amazon Payments, and Internet search engines such as Google, Bing and Yahoo (collectively, the “Third-Party Providers”) shall, within five (5) business days after receipt of such notice, provide to Plaintiff expedited discovery, including copies of all documents and records in such person’s or entity’s possession or control relating to:


a. the identities and locations of Defendants, their agents, servants, employees, confederates, attorneys, and any persons acting in concert or participation with them, including all known contact information, including any and all associated e-mail addresses;

- b.** the nature of Defendants’ operations and all associated sales, methods of payment for services and financial information, including, without limitation, identifying information associated with the Defendant Online Stores and Defendants’ financial accounts, as well as providing a full accounting of Defendants’ sales and listing history related to their respective Defendant Online Stores;
 - c.** any of the Defendant Online Stores;
 - d.** any other online marketplace accounts registered by Defendants; and
 - e.** any financial accounts owned or controlled by Defendants, including their agents, servants, employees, confederates, attorneys, and any persons acting in concert or participation with them, including such accounts residing with or under the control of any banks, savings and loan associations, payment processors or other financial institutions, including, without limitation, PayPal and Amazon Pay, or other merchant account providers, payment providers, third party processors, and credit card associations (*e.g.*, MasterCard and VISA).
- 3.** Upon Plaintiff’s request, those in privity with Defendants and those with notice of the injunction, including the Third-Party Providers as defined in Paragraph 2, shall within five (5) business days after receipt of such notice:

- a. disable and cease providing services being used by Defendants, currently or in the future, to engage in the sale of goods using the Plaintiff Works;
 - b. disable and cease displaying any advertisements used by or associated with Defendants in connection with the sale of counterfeit and infringing goods using the Plaintiff Works; and
 - c. take all steps necessary to prevent links to the Defendant Online Stores from displaying in search results, including, but not limited to, removing links to the Defendant Online Stores from any search index.
4. Defendants and any persons in active concert or participation with them who have actual notice of this Order shall be temporarily restrained and enjoined from transferring or disposing of any money or other of Defendants' assets until further ordered by this Court.
5. PayPal, Inc. ("PayPal"), Amazon Payments, Inc., and any banks, savings and loan associations, payment processors, or other financial institutions shall, within two (2) business days of receipt of this Order, for any Defendant or any of the Defendant Online Stores:
 - a. locate all accounts and funds connected to Defendants or the Defendant Online Stores, including, but not limited to, any PayPal or Amazon Payment accounts connected to the and any e-mail addresses provided for Defendants by third parties; and

- b. restrain and enjoin any such accounts or funds that are not U.S. based from transferring or disposing of any money or other of Defendants' assets until further ordered by this Court.
6. Pursuant to this Court's discretion, Plaintiff shall not presently be required to post a bond or other security. BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. v. MCIMetro Access Transmission Servs., LLC, 425 F.3d 964, 971 (11th Cir. 2005). However, any Defendant may appear and immediately challenge this portion of the Order by providing the Court with a reasonable estimation of its potential lost sales, along with supporting documentation sufficient to allow the Court to decide what an appropriate amount of surety would be. Plaintiff will then have two (2) weeks in which to file a response.
7. This Temporary Restraining Order without notice shall remain in effect for fourteen (14) days.
