Sealed Temporary Restraining Order

THIS CAUSE being before the Court on Plaintiff Union Imagination Tech. Co. Ltd. (“Plaintiff”) *Ex Parte* Motion for Entry of a Temporary Restraining Order, Including a Temporary Injunction, a Temporary Asset Restraint, and Expedited Discovery [Dkt. 6] and Motion to File Under Seal [Dkt. 9] (the “Motions”) against TengXianTaiPingXingHeBaiHuoShangHang d/b/a PASOLABE (the “Defendant”) using at least the online marketplace account identified in Schedule A hereto (the “Defendant Online Store”), and this Court having heard the evidence before it hereby GRANTS Plaintiff’s Motions.

This Court finds that Plaintiff is the exclusive owner of all right, title, and interest in and to the United States Copyright Registration Nos. VA 2-461-023, VA 2-459-366, VA 2-460-834, VA 2-460-838, VA 2-460-840, VA2-461-006, VA2-460-996, VA 2-460-832, VA2-461-003, VA2-461-031, VA 2-461-019, VA 2-460-989, VA2-460-985, VA 2-460-843, VA2-461-021, VA 2-461-027, VA 2-461-016, VA2-460-993, VA 2-461-004, and VA 2-461-193 (the “Plaintiff Copyrights”), which protect images therein, that Plaintiff uses to advertise its products (collectively, the “Plaintiff Works”).

This Court further finds that it has personal jurisdiction over the Defendant since the Defendant directly targets their business activities toward consumers in the United States, including

Illinois. Specifically, Defendant is reaching out to do business with Illinois residents by operating one or more commercial, interactive Defendant Online Stores through which Illinois residents can and have purchased products which are sold through the unauthorized reproduction, display, and exploitation of the Plaintiff Works.

This Court also finds that issuing this Order without notice pursuant to Rule 65(b)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure is appropriate because Plaintiff has presented specific facts in the Declaration of Huifang Qu [Dkt. 7] in support of Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order [Dkt. 6], and accompanying evidence clearly showing that immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage will result to the movant before the adverse party can be heard in opposition.

Specifically, in the absence of an *ex parte* Order, Defendant could and likely would modify registration data and content and move any assets from accounts in U.S.-based financial institutions, including without limitation Amazon Pay, PayPal, and/or eBay accounts, to offshore accounts. *Id.* Proceedings against those who deliberately traffic in counterfeit merchandise are often useless if notice is given to the adverse party.

Accordingly, this Court orders that:

1. Defendant, their affiliates, officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, confederates, and all persons acting for, with, by, through, under, or in active concert with them be temporarily enjoined and restrained from:
 - a. reproducing, distributing copies of, making derivative works of, or publicly displaying the Plaintiff Works in any manner without the express authorization of Plaintiff;
 - b. committing any acts calculated to cause consumers to believe that Defendant's products are those sold under the authorization, control, or supervision of Plaintiff, or are sponsored by, approved by, or otherwise connected with Plaintiff; and

- e. any financial accounts owned or controlled by Defendant, including their agents, servants, employees, confederates, attorneys, and any persons acting in concert or participation with them, including such accounts residing with or under the control of any banks, savings and loan associations, payment processors or other financial institutions, including, without limitation, PayPal, AliPay, Payoneer, Skrill, Ping Pong, and Amazon Payments, or other merchant account providers, payment providers, third party processors, and credit card associations (*e.g.*, MasterCard and VISA).
3. Upon Plaintiff's request, those in privity with Defendant and those with notice of the injunction, including the Third-Party Providers as described in Paragraph 2, shall within five (5) business days after receipt of such notice:
 - a. disable and cease providing services being used by Defendant, currently or in the future, to engage in the sale of goods through the exploitation of the Plaintiff Works;
 - b. disable and cease displaying any advertisements incorporating the Plaintiff Works used by or associated with Defendant; and
 - c. take all steps necessary to prevent links to the Listing URLs identified on **Schedule A** hereto from displaying in search results, including, but not limited to, removing those links from any search index.
4. Defendant and any persons in active concert or participation with them (*e.g.*, Third-Party Providers) who have actual notice of this Order shall be temporarily restrained and enjoined from transferring or disposing of any money earned by each Defendant from its sales of any of the ASINs identified in **Schedule A** (collectively, the "Accused Revenue") until further ordered by this Court.

5. eBay, PayPal, Amazon Payments, and any banks, savings and loan associations, payment processors, or other financial institutions, including any Third-Party Providers, shall, within five (5) calendar days of receipt of this Order, for Defendant or the Defendant Online Store:
 - a. locate all accounts and funds connected to Defendant or the Defendant Online Store, including, but not limited to, any eBay, PayPal, and Amazon Payments accounts connected to the Defendant Online Store identified in Schedule A hereto and any e-mail addresses provided for Defendant by third parties; and
 - b. restrain and enjoin, up to the amount of the Accused Revenue, any such accounts or funds from transferring or disposing of any money or other of Defendant's assets until further ordered by this Court.
6. Plaintiff is authorized to issue expedited written discovery, pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 33, 34, and 36, related to:
 - a. the identities and locations of Defendant, its affiliates, officers, agents, servants, employees, confederates, attorneys, and any persons acting in concert or participation with them, including all known contact information, including any and all associated e-mail addresses; and
 - b. the nature of Defendant's operations and all associated sales, methods of payment for services and financial information, including, without limitation, identifying information associated with the Defendant's Seller Alias and Defendant's financial accounts, as well as providing a full accounting of Defendant's sales and listing history related to its respective e-commerce or other store(e).
7. Plaintiff is authorized to issue the expedited discovery requests authorized by Paragraph 6 via e-mail. Defendant shall respond to any such discovery requests within three (3) business days of being served via e-mail.

8. The Exhibit 1 and Schedule A to the Complaint [Dkt. 4], Declaration of Huifang Qu and accompanying exhibits [Dkt. 7], and this Order shall remain sealed until further ordered by this Court.
9. Plaintiff shall deposit with the Court one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), either cash, law firm check, or surety bond, as security, which amount was determined adequate for the payment of such damages as any person may be entitled to recover as a result of a wrongful restraint hereunder.
10. Any Defendant that is subject to this Order may appear and move to dissolve or modify the Order as permitted by and in compliance with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and the Northern District of Illinois Local Rules. Any third party impacted by this Order may move for appropriate relief.
11. This Temporary Restraining Order without notice is entered at 3:30 pm on this 13th day of January 2026 and shall remain in effect for fourteen (14) days.
