Preliminary Injunction Order

THIS CAUSE being before the Court on the motion for entry of preliminary injunction by Plaintiff Union Imagination Tech. Co. Ltd. (“Plaintiff”) (the “Motion”) against TengXianTaiPingXingHeBaiHuoShangHang d/b/a PASOLABE (the “Defendant”) using at least the online marketplace account identified in Schedule A hereto (the “Defendant Online Store”). After reviewing the Motion and the accompanying record, this Court GRANTS Plaintiff’s Motion as follows.

The Court finds Plaintiff has provided notice to Defendants in accordance with the order on electronic service [Dkt. 27] and Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(a)(1).

This Court finds that Plaintiff is the exclusive owner of all right, title, and interest in and to the United States Copyright Registration Nos. VA2-461-023, VA 2-459-366, VA 2-460-834, VA 2-460-838, VA 2-460-840, VA2-461-006, VA2-460-996, VA 2-460-832, VA2-461-003, VA2-461-031, VA 2-461-019, VA 2-460-989, VA2-460-985, VA 2-460-843, VA2-461-021, VA 2-461-027, VA 2-461-016, VA2-460-993, VA 2-461-004, VA 2-461-193 (the “Plaintiff Copyrights”), which protect images therein, that Plaintiff uses to advertise its products (collectively, the “Plaintiff Works”).

This Court further finds that it has personal jurisdiction over the Defendant since the Defendant directly targets their business activities toward consumers in the United States, including

Illinois. Specifically, Defendant is reaching out to do business with Illinois residents by operating one or more commercial, interactive Defendant Online Stores through which Illinois residents can and have purchased at least one product which was sold through the unauthorized reproduction, display, and exploitation of the Plaintiff Works.

This Court also finds that the injunctive relief previously granted in the TRO should remain in place through the pendency of this litigation and that issuing this Preliminary Injunction is warranted under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65. Evidence submitted in support of this Motion and in support of Plaintiff's previously granted Motion for Entry of a TRO establishes that Plaintiff has demonstrated a likelihood of success on the merits; that no remedy at law exists; and that Plaintiff will suffer irreparable harm if the injunction is not granted.

Specifically, Plaintiff has proved a *prima facie* case of copyright infringement because: (i) the Plaintiff Works are registered with the U.S. Copyright Office; and (ii) Defendant is not licensed or authorized to exploit the Plaintiff Works. Furthermore, Defendants' continued and unauthorized use of the Plaintiff Work irreparably harms Plaintiff through diminished goodwill and brand confidence, damage to Plaintiff's reputation, loss of exclusivity, and loss of future sales. Monetary damages fail to address such damage and, therefore, Plaintiff has an inadequate remedy at law. Moreover, the public interest is served by entry of this Preliminary Injunction to dispel the public confusion created by Defendants' actions. Accordingly, this Court orders that:

Accordingly, this Court orders that:

1. For the duration of this action, Defendant and its affiliates, officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, confederates, and all persons acting for, with, by, through, under, or in active concert with Defendant having notice of this Order is hereby ORDERED to cease and refrain from:
 - a. reproducing, distributing copies of, making derivative works of, or publicly displaying the Plaintiff Works in any manner without the express authorization of Plaintiff; and

- b.** manufacturing, shipping, delivering, holding for sale, transferring or otherwise moving, storing, distributing, returning, or otherwise disposing of, in any manner, products or inventory not manufactured or authorized by or for Plaintiff and which bear any of the Plaintiff Works.
- 2.** For the duration of this action, Defendant must preserve all documents and electronically stored information arising from or related to its sale, offer for sale, distribution, and advertising, incorporating the Plaintiff Works or components thereof, of products through its online storefronts located on Amazon.com or elsewhere.
- 3.** Defendant and any third party with actual notice of this Order who is providing services for Defendant, or in connection with the Defendant Online Store or other online marketplace accounts operated by Defendant, including, without limitation, any online marketplace platforms such as Amazon, eBay, web hosts, sponsored search engine or ad-word providers, credit cards, banks, merchant account providers, third party processors and other payment processing service providers such as PayPal, AliPay, Payoneer, Skrill, Ping Pong, and Amazon Payments, and Internet search engines such as Google, Bing and Yahoo (collectively, the “Third-Party Providers”) shall, within five (5) business days after receipt of such notice, provide to Plaintiff expedited discovery, including copies of all documents and records in such person’s or entity’s possession or control relating to:
 - a.** the identity and location of Defendant, their agents, servants, employees, confederates, attorneys, and any persons acting in concert or participation with them, including all known contact information, including any and all associated e-mail addresses;
 - b.** the nature of Defendant’s operations and all associated sales, methods of payment for services and financial information, including, without limitation, identifying information associated with the Defendant Online Store and Defendant’s financial accounts, as well

- as providing a full accounting of Defendant's sales and listing history related to their respective Defendant Online Store;
- c. any other online marketplace accounts registered by Defendant; and
 - d. any financial accounts owned or controlled by Defendant, including their agents, servants, employees, confederates, attorneys, and any persons acting in concert or participation with them, including such accounts residing with or under the control of any banks, savings and loan associations, payment processors or other financial institutions, including, without limitation, PayPal, AliPay, Payoneer, Skrill, Ping Pong, and Amazon Payments, or other merchant account providers, payment providers, third party processors, and credit card associations (*e.g.*, MasterCard and VISA).
4. Upon Plaintiff's request, those in privity with Defendant and those with notice of the injunction, including the Third-Party Providers as described in Paragraph 3, shall within five (5) business days after receipt of such notice:
- a. disable and cease providing services being used by Defendant, currently or in the future, to engage in the sale of goods through the exploitation of the Plaintiff Works;
 - b. disable and cease displaying any advertisements incorporating the Plaintiff Works used by or associated with Defendant; and
 - c. take all steps necessary to prevent links to the Listing URLs identified on **Schedule A** hereto from displaying in search results, including, but not limited to, removing those links from any search index.
5. Defendant and any persons in active concert or participation with it (*e.g.*, Third-Party Providers) who has actual notice of this Order shall be temporarily restrained and enjoined from transferring or disposing of any money earned by each Defendant from its sales of any of the

ASINs identified in **Schedule A**, *i.e.*, \$232,489.40 (collectively, the “Accused Revenue”) until further ordered by this Court.

6. For the duration of this action, all Third-Party Providers which receive notice of this Order shall continue to attach and freeze all funds in any account(s) owned, controlled, utilized by, or associated with the Defendant and otherwise prohibit the transfer of any funds up to the Accused Revenue of any such accounts. No funds restrained by this Order shall be transferred or surrendered by any Third-Party Provider for any purpose (other than pursuant to a chargeback made pursuant to their security interest in the funds) without the express authorization of the Court.
7. Plaintiff is authorized to issue expedited written discovery, pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 33, 34, and 36, related to:
 - a. the identities and locations of Defendant, its affiliates, officers, agents, servants, employees, confederates, attorneys, and any persons acting in concert or participation with them, including all known contact information, including any and all associated e-mail addresses; and
 - b. the nature of Defendant’s operations and all associated sales, methods of payment for services and financial information, including, without limitation, identifying information associated with the Defendant’s Seller Alias and Defendant’s financial accounts, as well as providing a full accounting of Defendant’s sales and listing history related to its respective e-commerce or other store(e).
8. Plaintiff is authorized to issue the expedited discovery requests authorized by Paragraph 7 via e-mail. Defendant shall respond to any such discovery requests within three (3) business days of being served via e-mail.
9. Docket entries 4, 7, 19, and 26 shall be unsealed.

10. The one-thousand-dollar (\$1,000) bond shall remain with the Court until a final disposition of this case or until this Preliminary Injunction is terminated.
11. Any Defendant that is subject to this Order may appear and move to dissolve or modify the Order as permitted by and in compliance with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and the Northern District of Illinois Local Rules. Any third party impacted by this Order may move for appropriate relief.
