ORDER

This case comes before the Court on Plaintiff Yun Liu's Motion to Extend Temporary Restraining Order and Continue Hearing ("Pl.'s Mot.") [Doc. 12]. The Court finds that Plaintiff has demonstrated good cause for an extension of the Temporary Restraining Order ("TRO") [Doc. 10] for an additional fourteen (14) days, through and including to July 24, 2026. Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Plaintiff's Motion is **GRANTED**. The previously entered TRO is extended until July 24, 2026.

Any response or opposition to Plaintiff's request for a preliminary injunction must be served on Plaintiff's counsel by **July 17, 2026**, and filed with the Court, along with Proof of Service. Plaintiff shall file any reply memorandum by **July 22, 2026**.

The hearing previously set before this Court in the United States Courthouse located at 75 Ted Turner Drive SW, Atlanta, Georgia 30303, Courtroom 1905, on July 10, 2026, at 9:30 A.M., is hereby **CANCELLED** and reset to **July 24, 2026**, at **9:30 A.M.** at which time Defendants and/or any other affected persons may challenge the appropriateness of the TRO and move to dissolve the same, and at which time the Court will hear argument on Plaintiff's requested preliminary injunction. Defendants shall appear and show cause why said preliminary injunction should not issue.
