ORDER FOR LEAVE TO CONDUCT EXPEDITED DISCOVERY

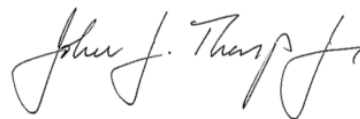
THIS CAUSE being before the Court on Plaintiff Union Imagination Tech. Co. Ltd. (“Plaintiff”) Motion to Reconsider [Dkt. 13] the Court’s denial of Plaintiff’s Ex Parte Amended Motion for Entry of a Temporary Restraining Order, Including a Temporary Injunction, a Temporary Asset Restraint, and Expedited Discovery (the “Motion”) against shenzhenshiyunqiyoudianzishangwuyouxiangonggsi d/b/a MHBEST (the “Defendant”) using at least the online marketplace account identified in Schedule A hereto (the “Defendant Online Store”), and this Court denying the Motion [Dkt. 14], nevertheless ORDERS that:

1. Defendant and any third party with actual notice of this Order who is providing services for Defendant, or in connection with the Defendant Online Store or other online marketplace accounts operated by Defendant, including, without limitation, any online marketplace platforms such as Amazon, eBay, web hosts, sponsored search engine or ad-word providers, credit cards, banks, merchant account providers, third party processors and other payment processing service providers such as PayPal, AliPay, Payoneer, Skrill, Ping Pong, and Amazon Payments, and Internet search engines such as Google, Bing and Yahoo (collectively, the “Third-Party Providers”) shall, within five (5) business days after receipt

of such notice, provide to Plaintiff expedited discovery, including copies of all documents and records in such person's or entity's possession or control relating to:

- a. the identity and location of Defendant, its agents, servants, employees, confederates, attorneys, and any persons acting in concert or participation with them, including all known contact information, including any and all associated e-mail addresses;
- b. the nature of Defendant's operations and all associated sales including delivery addresses, methods of payment for services and financial information, including, without limitation, identifying information associated with the Defendant Online Store and Defendant's financial accounts, as well as providing a full accounting of Defendant's sales and listing history related to their respective Defendant Online Store;
- c. the Defendant Online Store;
- d. any other online marketplace accounts registered by Defendant; and
- e. any financial accounts owned or controlled by Defendant, including their agents, servants, employees, confederates, attorneys, and any persons acting in concert or participation with them, including such accounts residing with or under the control of any banks, savings and loan associations, payment processors or other financial institutions, including, without limitation, PayPal, AliPay, Payoneer, Skrill, Ping Pong, and Amazon Payments, or other merchant account providers, payment providers, third party processors, and credit card associations (e.g., MasterCard and VISA).
